A few trees. Draw the structures for the following sentences in (1), (2) and (3). Follow the examples from the handouts. In this homework, we're interested mostly in the case and agreement features, but write all uninterpretable features under the head they belong to, as in previous homeworks. Cross out the features as they are checked. If you move a head, draw the complex head (Adjunction). If you move anything, draw < > around the trace. Follow examples from handout 11 (Passive) and the example below. You should draw the final (complete) tree, rather than steps—and if something moves, draw it in its moved (final) position.

- (1) The giant puddle evaporated in the sunlight.
- (2) The bagel was not eaten by me.
- (3) A surprised whale contemplated the approaching ground.

Example: I was slapped.
